

Initial notifications to persons in parental relations and staff pursuant to section 409H of State Education Law

Dear Parents, Gaudian, and School staff:

New York state Education Law Section 409H, effective July 1,2001, requires all public schools and nonpublic elementary schools to provide written notification to all persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year.

The Edgemont school is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff who wish to receive 48 -hour written notification of certain pesticide applications. The following list pesticide applications are not subject to prior notification requirements.

- A school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72 hours following application
- Anti-microbial products
- Nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children
- Nonvolatile insecticides baits in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children
- Silica gels and other nonvolatile ready to use pastes, foams, gels in areas inaccessible to children
- Boric acid and disodium octa borate tetrahydrates
- The application of EPA designated biopesticide
- The application of RPA designated exempt material under 40CFR152.25
- The use of aerosol products with direct spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect from Imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous siders, bees, wasps, and hornets.

In the event of an emergency application necessary to protect against Imminent treat to human health, a good faith effort will be made to supply written notification to those on the 48- hour notification list.
